Fall Musings from the President...

Our 25th Rolan Johnson ornament for 2019 is titled "There is a Peace." I felt this was a most appropriate theme for not only this ornament, but for my comments in this edition of our Prints newsletter. At this particular time, there is an urgency to focus on Peace. Our world, our nation, our state and our city are all in desperate need of the gift of Peace.

The struggle for peace is not new, but has been a part of human history since the beginning. Our Bible bears truth to this fact as the term *peace* appears more than 250 times in the Old Testament. This notion of peace

continues in the New Testament where *peace* is referred to 91 times, and Ephesians 6:15 calls the Christian message, the Gospel of Peace.

The peace referred to in the Scriptures is not just the cessation of war, conflict and violence. Peace in the Scriptures is the result of God's presence in a person's life since God is the source of that peace. In John 14:27, Jesus promises, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you, not as the world gives, do I give to you." Our true peace comes from our relationship with the Prince of Peace who promises His presence in all the circumstances of our lives, especially the difficult times. We need only to heed the words of that famous hymn, "Let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me," knowing that the source of our peace is found in our Lord and Savior, Jesus.

Professed Vows: June 12, 1949 **Education**: Bachelor's degree from

St. Ambrose University, Davenport, Iowa; master's degree from Cardinal Stritch University, Milwaukee, Wisconsin

Ministries: Sister Mary Patricia taught at St. Philomena School in Peoria (1949-52), St. Joseph School in Pekin (1952-54), Immaculate Conception School in Spring Valley (1954-56), Bishop Dunne School at Guardian Angel Home in Peoria (1957-61), St. Mary School in Metamora (1961-62), and Sacred Heart School in Moline (1972-82). She also worked with the elderly at St. Joseph's Home of Springfield from 1982 to 1985 and from 1993 to 2017.

Sister Mary Patricia served her community as director of new Sisters from 1962 to 1972, and was president from 1985 to 1993.

Comments: "For me the attraction to religious life was initiated by a direct invitation from Sisters to join them in their life of dedication and service to God and his people," Sister Mary Patricia said. "In time I accepted this invitation and joined the Sisters of St. Francis of the Immaculate Conception."

Her two families - family of origin and religious family (community) - have provided the support needed for a happy, dedicated life to God.

Sister Mary Patricia said those discerning a vocation shouldn't be afraid. "My belief is that women will find happiness if they respond to God's call to religious life."

Education: Bachelor's degree from

St. Ambrose College, Davenport, Iowa; master's degrees from the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, and LaSalle College, Philadelphia

Ministries: A longtime educator, Sister Mary Ann taught second grade at St. Mary School in Canton (1959-63) and St. Mary School in Metamora (1963-68), English at Alleman High School in Rock Island (1968-70), and English and religion at Bergan High School in Peoria (1971-81). She also served as director of religious education at St. Philomena Parish in Peoria from 1981 to 1997, and administrator at Mother of Peace Home in West Peoria from 2002 to 2016.

Comments: "It has been a joy and privilege to belong to my religious community, the Sisters of St. Francis of the Immaculate Conception, these 60 years.

"The Sisters have been a source of inspiration in prayer and charity in living the Franciscan life. Their compassion for me when I was recovering from a serious car accident was truly lifegiving as I was making a year's recovery. These are some of the joy-filled treasures among the many, too numerous to mention, but kept in my heart with gratitude."



Sister Irene Marie Fritch, OSF - 50 years

Home Parish: St. Anthony, Matherville **Professed Vows**: Aug. 9, 1969

Education: Bachelor's degree in elementary education from Bradley University; master's degree in religious studies from Saint Louis University, St. Louis

Ministries: Sister Irene taught at St. Joseph School in Pekin (1970-76), Sacred Heart School in Moline (1976-78), and Epiphany School in Normal, where she also served as principal (1978-82). She was

treasurer and vice president for her community, and facility director at Immaculate Conception Convent from 1982 to 1997, and was president from 2001 to 2009. Sister Irene has been formation director for the Sisters of St. Francis of the Immaculate Conception since then, and was elected vice president in 2017.

Comments: "Throughout these past 50 years, my life with my sisters in community and my service in each of my ministries have brought me the most joy. The love and support of my sisters has strengthened me and enabled me to strive to use my education, talents, and experiences to serve to the best of my ability. They truly are 'sisters' to me in every sense of the word."

She noted that she has also been enriched through the various ministries assigned to her.

"I have had a wonderful, happy life."

Sister Janice Keenan, OSF - 50 years

Home Parish: St. Mary, Wenona **Professed Vows**: August 9, 1969

Education: Bachelor's degree in secondary education and mathematics from Bradley

University; master's degree in education administration from Saint Mary's University of Minnesota; courses in theology at Viterbo College, La Crosse, Wisconsin, and religious studies at Saint Louis University, St. Louis

Ministries: Sister Janice taught junior high at St. Joseph School in Pekin (1970-73), was a junior high teacher and co-principal at St. Philomena School in Peoria (1973-80), and principal at St. Mary School in Metamora (1980-87). She served her community as vocation director from 1987 to 1991, formation director from 1991 to 2001, and bookkeeper, motherhouse coordinator and kitchen supervisor at Immaculate Conception Convent from 2001 to 2002.

The director of campus ministry at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Newman Center in Macomb from 2011 to 2015, Sister Janice has been retreat program manager and spiritual director at the Portiuncula Center for Prayer since then.

Comments: "Being called to consecrated life as a Sister is for me a gift and a blessing from a loving God, I was blessed with wonderful, loving parents, six sisters and two brothers, and grew up Catholic on a farm and in small towns. All this gave me a sense of being rooted in faith, an experience of a variety of individuals, a sense of community, and an appreciation of nature."

She found a second home with her religious community, "where faith, respect for each person, supportive community and awareness of God at work in creation were at the heart of what it means to be Franciscan."

"What gives me the most joy is being loved so much by a good and gracious God and being able to follow Jesus using the gifts God gave me to be of service to others."

Her advice to someone discerning a vocation to religious life is to believe that God loves them, wants them to be happy, and will be with them each day as they use the gifts He's given them in service.

Sister Janice's advice for those considering the Religious life - "Pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and be willing to give yourself wholeheartedly and generously, trusting that you'll be blessed abundantly."



Sister Jacqueline Schroeder, OSF - 50 years

Home Parish: Sacred Heart, Moline, IL

Professed Vows: August 9, 1969

Education: Bachelor's degree from Bradley University, master's degree in religious education from St. Thomas University, Houston, Texas, and studies in spiritual direction in Cincinnati, Ohio, and an Anamcara apprenticeship from Sacred Heart of Living Center, Bend, Oregon

Ministries: Sister Jacque taught at Epiphany School in Normal for four years and St. Mary School in Metamora for seven years, including three years as principal. She also served as diocesan director of Teens Encounter Christ, national spiritual director of TEC, diocesan co-spiritual director of Cursillo, and chaplain at OSF HealthCare Saint Francis Medical Center in Peoria. She was also novice director for her religious community for nine years. Sister Jacque is in her third year at Standing Rock Reservation, where she had previously served for eight years.

Comments: To reflect on her vocation, Sister Jacque quoted the St. Louis Jesuits' song, "Earthen Vessels": "We hold a treasure, not made of gold, in earthen vessels, wealth untold. One treasure only, the Lord, the Christ, in earthen vessels."

"Jesus is the one treasure and he has chosen the lowly, the small, the weak that God's glory might shine through us. He chose me! And if Jesus can choose this little, weak one, He can certainly choose you!"

Those who want to know God's will for them should do three things..

The first is to listen. "Be still. Listen to God in nature, in Scripture, in the wisdom of the church.

The second is to surround yourself with wise people --- "people who can listen with you and offer the wisdom of the lived experience of their own relationship with God," she said. "Learn from them. Follow the example of the saints!"

The third is to choose every day. "Choose a loving relationship with God as the one most important thing in this life. God is already 'head over heels' in love with you - look for ways to return this love. I guarantee that God will never be outdone in generosity."


